

Qualifying List Procedures for Children's/Adult Hunters & Jumpers and Low Jr./Amateur Owner Jumper Divisions

Each of the 10 USHJA Zones had the opportunity to have three of their top-ranked horses (by points/prize money) included on the initial Qualifying Lists. If a Zone was not able to provide three horses eligible for the Qualifying List, the maximum number of horses available by the Zone were accepted.

From there, the additional horses were added to the Qualifying Lists in order from maximum points/prize money to the least amount. For the Hunter divisions, a maximum of 25 horses can be on the Qualified List, and a maximum of 30 horses are included for the Jumper divisions.

Following these lists, viewers will find a section labeled "Waitlist – With Points." These horses are the next to move on to the Qualifying List based on the acceptance rate. The final section is the "Waitlist – Without Points". Riders on this list may need to contact USHJA and/or USEF to resolve any point disputes.

Management has the ability and responsibility to move the "Waitlisted Horses" to the Qualified List after qualified horses have declined acceptance or a point resolution has been resolved.
