RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES

ENTRIES:

CLOSING DATE: Entries must be received before Midnight EDT, as follows:

Hunter and Jumper......Thursday, August 31, 2023
Equitation, Side Saddle.....Monday, September 11, 2023

The Pennsylvania National Horse Show limits the number of competitors in each section and your entry is an application to compete subject to the qualifying criteria published in this prize list. Your application must be paid, submitted, and received by the closing date or your entry will automatically be waitlisted because it cannot be included in the data submitted to USEF for ranking.

All applications (entries) must be submitted electronically through the Show Management SystemTM Platform: https://entries.showmanagementsystem.com/which will separately collect a \$5.75 non-refundable entry processing fee in addition to the mandatory, non-refundable \$150 qualifying and office fee.

SHOW MANAGEMENT SYSTEMTM HORSE SHOW ENTRY PLATFORM

You need a free Show Management System[™] account to use this application. CREATE ACCOUNT entries.showmanagementsystem.com

All communications related to the qualification process will be handled through the e-mail address of the user submitting the entry. If your application is accepted, you will receive a summary of the entry fees due, the steps necessary to accept your invitation to compete, and a link to pay for your balance. Acceptances and payment must be received by the date specified in the acceptance email or your spot will be given to a waitlisted entry.

All entries must complete the W9 request for taxpayer identification as part of the entry process or any prize monies due will be withheld. All show fees can be paid for with a check or a credit card with a 3% credit card processing fee. This information will be included in your acceptance letter as the method of payment options.

Before entering, it is the responsibility of the rider/owner/trainer to confirm eligibility. Your emailed acceptance packet will contain final details on arrival procedures and health requirements for the 2023 event.

QUALIFYING ENTRY PROCEDURE FOR HUNTERS & JUMPERS

(exceptions) - Side Saddle & Medal Finals - for which all fees must accompany entry form

Any horse applying for acceptance in any hunter section must have competed in that section within the qualifying period.

For horses applying to compete in a section with USEF National HOTY Points: PNHS will use US Equestrian National Horse of the Year points or money won, as applicable, received at shows starting on or after Aug 15, 2022 through shows starting on or before Aug. 13, 2023 as means of qualification using the best points earned or money won, per GR915.3(1), at no more than 15 horse shows during this time period. Applications submitted by the closing date will be ranked by points earned within their section and the top horses in each section will receive invitation to compete at the 2023 Show. See page 19 for acceptance numbers for each section. The remaining on time applications will be waitlisted in descending order by points earned.

Entries submitted after the closing date will be added at the bottom of the waitlist irrespective of their points.

For all sections at PNHS, if any section fails to fill the total number to be accepted allowed then management reserves the right to increase the number of applicants accepted in any other section, subject to the limitations of the schedule.

All entries in a section will be final at 5pm the evening prior to the start of each section.

Amateur Jumpers: Amateurs may claim only money won in 1.30m - 1.35m Amateur classes.

Open Jumpers: will qualify based USEF GR914.3(b2) based on prize money won at shows starting on or after August 15, 2022 through shows ending on or before August 13, 2023.

JOG: Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion.

SCRATCH POLICY

Horses entered may be scratched by notifying the show secretary IN WRITING VIA EMAIL ONLY TheHorseShowOffice@gmail.com.

- If written notification is received prior to 8:00am EST September 18, 2023 all prepaid fees minus the \$150 (application fee) will be returned.
- If written notification is received after 8:00am EST September 18, 2023, but prior to 8:00am EST September 25, 2023, half of prepaid fees minus the \$150 application fee will be returned.
- After September 25, 2023, no portion of entries or fees will be refunded.
- In the event of the cancellation of the show, PNHS will refund the \$150 application fee along with any additional payments made prior to the cancellation date.

PRIZE MONEY ALL ENTRIES IN PRIZE MONEY CLASSES MUST PROVIDE A VALID AND COMPLETE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OR FEDERAL TAX ID AS WELL AS CURRENT/VALID MAILING ADDRESS. All prize monies will be mailed within 30 days after the completion of the show to the holder of the W-9 attached to the entry. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that the Show office has their correct and complete Social Security number or Federal Tax ID as well as current/VALID mailing address. A completed W-9 is required for each entry. Prize money will be paid to the individual listed on the W-9. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS to this policy. PRIZE MONEY CHECKS WILL NOT BE REISSUED.

PRIZE MONEY CHECKS/REFUNDS NOT CASHED WITHIN 90 DAYS OF DATE OF ISSUE WILL BE CONSIDERED NULL AND VOID AND DEEMED A DONATION TO THE PNHS FOUNDATION.

CROSS ENTRIES: Before entering, it is the responsibility of the rider/owner/trainer to confirm eligibility.

Penn National Adult Hunter Finals: Horse/Rider combination may not compete in any other hunter classes where fences exceed 3'. Rider may not compete in any other hunter class at this Show where fences are set above 3'6". Horse may, with a different rider, compete in any other class for which it is eligible and qualified, except AO Hunter. Riders may, if qualified, show one other horse in each AO Section.

Penn National Children's Hunter Finals: Horse/Rider combination may not compete in any other class at this Show, except USEF Hunter Seat Medal Final and/or Equitation Training Session. Rider may not compete in any other hunter class at this Show where fences are set at 3'3" or higher, except USEF Medal Final, Equitation Training Session and jumper classes 1.15m and below. Horse may, with a different rider, compete in any other class for which it is eligible and qualified.

Penn National Adult Jumper Finals: Horse/Rider combination may only compete in the Adult Jumper Division at this Show. Rider may not compete in the Amateur or Open Jumper Section at this Show. Horse may, with a different rider, compete in any other class for which it is eligible and qualified and Hunter divisions they are eligible for.

Penn National Children's Jumper Finals: Horse/Rider combination may only compete in the Children's Jumper Division at this Show, except USEF Hunter Seat Medal Final and/or Equitation Training Session Rider may not compete in the Prix de States Junior Jumper or Open Jumper Section at this Show. Horse may, with a different rider, compete in any other class for which it is eligible and qualified and Hunter divisions they are eligible for.

Penn National Low Jr Jumper Final: Horse/Rider combination may not compete in any other class at this Show. Horse may, with a different rider, compete in any other class for which it is eligible and qualified. Riders in this class may show no more than one other horse in either the Penn National Horse Show Adult or Children's Jumper Finals or in the Prix de States Jr Jumper Championship and Hunter divisions they are eligible for.

Penn National Low Amateur Jumper Final: Horse/Rider combination may not compete in any other class at this Show. Horse may, with a different rider, compete in any other class for which it is eligible and qualified. Riders in this class may show no more than one other horse in either the Penn National Horse Show Adult or Children's Jumper Finals or in the Prix de States Jr Jumper Championship or two horses in the Amateur and Hunter divisions they are eligible for.

- Dogs on the Farm Show property MUST be kept caged or on a leash.
- Dogs in violation of either of these rules will be collected by the Humane Society and held for the owner, who will be fined \$100.00.
- If you do not intend to abide by these rules, DO NOT bring your dog(s) to the Pennsylvania National Horse Show.



All showing horses will be charged a \$30 Video Fee that will enable them to view and share all their rounds during the show. To find your video, follow the link on the website (under EXHIBITOR TAB at www.PAnational.org) and then search for the horse/rider/class name, or back/class number. From there, videos can be watched online, downloaded, and/or shared to Facebook. If there is a problem with the video or you need technical support, click the Report button or send an email to bethany.myhorse.video@gmail.com.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

- 1) Pennsylvania National will adhere to USEF guidelines with regard to the minimum number of entries required to maintain a class.
- 2) The organizer reserves the right to refuse to accept any entry and to return any entry fees, stabling fees, and other charges before or during the horse show without liability for any compensation to the refused party.
- 3) All visitors to and participants at the horse show assume responsibility for their own safety and the horse show will not be liable for any injury to any human or animal or for damage or loss to any property brought to the event.
- 4) Competitors, trainers, and grooms are responsible for staying abreast of changes in the schedule and be prepared to enter the ring based on the posted order of go.
- 5) Exhibitors are responsible for collecting their official back number prior to competing and will have it on their person or mount at all times when competing or participating in a restricted schooling session.
- 6) Once a class has commenced only the competitors, officials, and ring crew are allowed in the Show Ring unless given special authorization by The Organizer.
- 7) Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, driver or groom, shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees.
- 8) The Organizer reserves the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the Show without being liable for compensation.
 - 9) No horse will be allowed in the Show Ring except at such hours as are announced.
- 10) Should any questions or disputes arise that are not provided for in the foregoing rules, the same shall be referred to The Organizer whose decision shall be final.
- 11) It is the tradition of the Show that riders and handlers be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly presented. Riders in all classes must wear headgear in accordance with GR801. The Organizer may in its discretion bar any person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience and must bar riders without protective headgear from classes in which it is required.
- 12) All exhibitors must present current proof of membership with USEF and USHJA or pay the \$30 USHJA show pass fee. USEF show passes must be obtained directly through USEF, only one USEF show pass is allowed per year.
- 13) All competitors in height restricted sections must have proof of current USEF measurement if their horse or pony's height cannot be electronically verified. (Large Jr Hunters do not need cards)
- 14) Any and all Hunter and Equitation classes may implement a "dotted line" to limit the size of the courtesy circle as denoted on the course plan and it is the competitor's responsibility to know when it is in effect.
- 15) Courses for all hunter classes will be over fences consisting of brush, aiken, post and rail, in and out, stone wall, coop and white gate and will be posted 30 minues prior to classes.
 - 16) A rotating jump order will be used in all classes over fences.
- 17) Championships will be awarded in all Hunter and Jumper Sections according to USEF rules unless otherwise noted.
- 18) All horses showing in the equitation, hunter or jumper divisions must present current USHJA Horse Registration and microchip. USEF Horse Recording is required for any horse showing in any ranking list Grand Prix.
- 19) The Organizer may fine exhibitors up to \$100.00 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.
- 20) PRIZE MONEY CHECKS/REFUNDS NOT CASHED WITHIN 90 DAYS OF DATE OF ISSUE WILL BE CONSIDERED NULL AND VOID AND DEEMED A DONATION TO THE PNHS FOUNDATION.
- 21) FEES: Payment of all fees must be made in US Funds. A penalty of \$50.00 will be charged for all non-negotiable funds. Management reserves the right to prohibit from competition and return the entry of any owner, rider, driver or trainer whose processing or entry fee payment has been returned as non-

GENERAL REGULATIONS cont'd

negotiable on one or more occasions. The Pennsylvania National Horse Show (PNHS) reserves the right to require guaranteed funds from exhibitors. All financial matters regarding the 2022 PNHS will be closed by December 31, 2023, NSF collection excepted. When you provide a check as payment, you authorize the PNHS either to use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check transaction. All show accounts must be closed out by 5 pm Sunday, October 22, 2023.

- 22) All showing horses will be charged a \$30 Video Fee that will enable them to view and share all their rounds during the show. To find your video, follow the link on the website (under EXHIBITOR TAB at www.PAnational.org) and then search for the horse/rider/class name, or back/class number. From there, videos can be watched online, downloaded, and/or shared to Facebook. If there is a problem with the video or you need technical support, click the Report button or send an email to bethany.myhorse.video@gmail.com.
- 23) Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

- 24) The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and The Organizer in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds.
 - 25) No Smoking is permitted in any buildings. Per USEF Rule 1301.8
- 26) No dogs are permitted on the main concourse or in the seating sections. Dogs will not be permitted anywhere else on the premises unless restrained on a leash. See page 19 for dog policy.
- 27) Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes
- 28) SAFE SPORT POLICY: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.
- 29) The Show committee requires that all horses and ponies stabled on the grounds must remain on the grounds from midnight prior to the start of the first class in their respective section until the conclusion of that section. (Exception: US Medal Final where more restrictive rules apply). Anyone found in violation will be barred from participation in any classes on the day of the infraction.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: A Negative Coggins Test dated within one year is required for each entry. ALL HORSES ON THE GROUNDS MUST COMPLY WITH AND PROVIDE PROOF OF VACCINATIONS PER USEF GR845. Any additional Health Requirements will be sent with acceptance

emails. To expedite processing upon your arrival at the show, please send a copy with your entry blank or acknowledgment. NO NUMBERS WILL BE RELEASED FROM OFFICE WITHOUT COGGINS OR VACCINATION PROOF.

ALL OUT OF STATE HORSES will require health certificates. Please contact your State Health Department for proper health and vaccine requirements.

30) PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR - (Excerpt from USEF Rule GR801). It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee, Competition Management, and Licensed Officials must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of PNHS (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

By signing below, I agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time, as well as all terms and provisions of this Prize List. If I am signing and submitting this Agreement electronically, I acknowledge that my electronic signature shall have the same validity, force and effect as if I affixed my signature by my own hand.

The Federation may provide the applicable Recognized Affiliate, Council, and discipline or breed committee with the Qualifying Criteria and Official Specifications for approval.

ENTRY FEE \$300.00 WARM UP CLASS: ENTRY FEE \$125.00

The NCEA Warm Up Class will be a full course, unjudged. Riders may do an additional round for \$50. This warm up is only for NCEA riders competing in the finals (no professionals).

Stabling for NCEA horses will be available starting WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2023 AT 9 AM. See page 23 for additional Stabling information.

1. Eligibility to Compete-Riders

- a. Rider Membership. Open to Junior Active Members of the Federation and Equine Canada.
- **b.** Riders are required to complete a USEF/NCEA Medal Program application prior to the start of the class in order for points to count.
 - 1. Riders must indicate on their USEF/NCEA Medal Program Application which ranking list they wish to accumulate points for (East, Midwest, West).
- c. Any rider in his or her final junior year may not compete in any qualifying classes held at a competition with a start date after August 31 of that competition year.
- d.The winner of any of the USEF/NCEA Junior Hunter Seat Medal Finals is no longer eligible to compete in USEF/NCEA Junior Hunter Seat Medal classes.

2. Eligibility to Compete-Horses

- a. All horses competing in USEF/NCEA Junior Hunter Seat Medal qualifying classes must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA in order for the rider to accumulate points.
- b. All horses competing in USEF/NCEA Junior Hunter Seat Medal qualifying classes and Final must provide a microchip number that verifies the animal's identity in order for the rider to accumulate points. The microchip must be compliant with EQ103.

3. Qualifying Criteria

- a. The qualifying period for the 2023 USEF/NCEA Junior Hunter Seat Medal Finals is August 21, 2022-August 20, 2023. Points from qualifying classes will count based on the start date of the competition.
- b. The top 50 riders from each ranking list (East, Midwest, West) will be invited to compete in the Finals.
- c. Points will be awarded using the following chart as base points and multiplying each placing by the number of riders that completed the course:

PLACINGS BASE POINTS	PLACINGS BASE POINTS
1st10	4th2
2nd6	5th 1
3rd4	6th ¹ / ₂

Classes that are split using the "California Split" method will determine the number of riders by take the total number that completed the course and dividing by the number of resulting sections (rounding up if the result is not a whole number).

4. Class Conditions

- a. The USEF/NCEA Junior Hunter Seat Medal Final will be a three phase competition (Over Fences, Flat, and Bracket).
- b. Conventional Hunter Seat Equitation style tack is required per EQ106.5a.
- c. Over Fences Phase: To be shown over a course of at least ten (10) hunter or jumper style fences at 3'3" in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course must include a double combination and a triple combination and at least two changes of direction. Water obstacles and liverpools are not permitted. An open numerical system of scoring must be used for the fences phase.
- d. Flat Phase: The top 20% or top ten scoring riders, whichever is greater, will return for the flat phase. An open numerical system of scoring must be used for the flat phase. The riders will be asked to perform 2 out of 3 of the following movements: shoulder in, haunches in, or leg yield both directions of the ring.
- e. Bracket Phase: The top four riders, as determined by the combination of the fences and flat phase (each counting equally), will return for the bracket phase. These four riders will enter the bracket phase on a clean slate and will not carry forward their scores from the previous rounds. The fourth and first place rider will compete over a course of at least 8 fences on the same horse. The second and third place rider will compete over a course of at least 8 fences on the same horse. The winners of each head to head will compete for the championship and reserve. Third and fourth place will be determined based on the scores from the first round of the bracket phase.
- f. The balance of the placings not determined by the bracket phase will be awarded based on the total combined score from the over fences and flat phase (each counting equally).



HUNTER SEAT EQUITATION DIVISION

All horses competing and any horse potentially competing in the USEF Hunter Seat Medal Final must be entered in the show office and pay all fees due by 5:00 PM EDT Thursday, October 12, 2023. Medal Draw to be determined.

- Spare equitation horses will be charged a fee of \$100, plus the cost of a junior weekend stall and office fee.
- The competition rider must declare their mount for the training session in the show office by 12:00 PM on Friday, October 13, 2023.
- All equitation paperwork (horse description, microchip number and stall location) must be completed and turned into show office no later than 5:00 pm EDT, Friday, October 13, 2023, unless arranged with horse show office.
- All horses competing and any horse potentially competing in the USEF Hunter Seat Medal Final must be on the competition grounds no later than 7:00 PM EDT on Friday, October 13, 2023. Horses must be physically presented at check-in location and have their microchip scanned. If a horse does not have microchip, a passport or copy of the horse's coggins must accompany the horse. All horses competing in the USEF Hunter Seat Medal Final must remain on the competition grounds until they have finished competing in all phases of the Final.
- Horses not checked in prior to 7:00 PM EDT on Friday, October 13, 2023 will not be permitted to compete in the USEF Hunter Seat Medal Final
- Horses are required to display the competition number at all times when the horse is outside of
 its stall.
- Riders may change horses before the start of the training session or USEF Hunter Seat Medal Final, provided the new horse was entered/declared/checked in as an equitation horse, as noted herein.

SCHOOLING AND LUNGING AREA RULES

The following rules will govern the use of the schooling and lunging areas.

- No horses are permitted in the official schooling area starting one hour prior to and until the completion of pony classes.
- Schooling and lunging areas will be available as determined and announced by Show Organizer.
- The setting of a course, utilizing only the equipment provided by Show Organizer will be permitted at the location and times designated and announced by Show Organizer.
- On competition days, the competition ring will be open for flatwork for equitation horses in the evening after the competition ends as follows:
 - Thursday for a minimum of two hours following the completion of the competition and the preparation of the footing
 - Friday for a minimum of two hours following the completion of the competition and the preparation of the footing
 - Saturday for a minimum of one hour following the completion of the competition and the preparation of the footing
- On Saturday evening prior to the USEF Hunter Seat Medal Final, the official schooling ring will be
 open for Equitation schooling following the completion of the competition for the day. Schooling
 will only be permitted during the hours designated by Show Organizer.
- On the morning of the USEF Hunter Seat Medal Finals, the official schooling area (the one closest to the Coliseum) will be set one hour before the start of the competition. The following rules will apply:
 - Approximately four schooling fences will be set as a straight line of oxers across the middle of the official schooling area
 - Each schooling fence will have at least four standards, four rails and four cups

SCHOOLING AND LUNGING AREA RULES (con't)

- Each schooling fence must be flagged
- Each schooling fence may be set as a vertical or as an oxer
- A one-stride combination consisting of two verticals may be set using the material at each schooling fence
- Show Organizer will provide a full variety of schooling materials and only this equipment may be utilized. No outside equipment is permitted. Additionally, no equipment may be set in such a way that it interferes with either the approach or landing of another jump.
- One jump will be designated as a "clean jump" and no materials (tarps, etc.) will be allowed on this jump.

All other USEF Schooling Rules for the Equitation section will be enforced. However, if there is a conflict between the USEF rules and these rules, these rules will prevail.

In the Harrisburg Coliseum schooling area, only Medal riders/trainers will be allowed until the completion of the Medal Finals.

Additional schooling times/restrictions will be sent with acknowledgement emails and posted online.

When the second round of the Medal Finals begins, only the trainer and groom are allowed in the entrance area leading in to the Coliseum. If you do not have a competitor in the top 25 working off, you will not be allowed in this area.

When the final testing phase begins, only the trainers and groom of the testing riders are permitted in this area.

These rules will be strictly enforced by the USEF.
