Keswick Hunt Club Earns Second Consecutive PNHS Hunt Night Championship

The 2022 Pennsylvania National Horse Show Hunt Night champions, the Keswick Hunt Club, returned to Harrisburg, PA, on Monday evening and successfully defended their title, earning the Hunt Night Championship and the Ralph A. Alfano Memorial Perpetual Trophy for the second year in a row.

In total, 19 hunt team combinations – made up of riders from 10 different Hunt Clubs from across Pennsylvania, Maryland and Virginia – took on Monday's Hunt Night competition, sponsored by Kinsley Construction and the Quaker City Foundation.

Throughout the evening, riders contested the offered Field Hunter, Hunter Under Saddle and Hunt Team classes with the aim of earning individual ribbons and points toward the championship for their team.

Earning the Leading Lady Rider Award was Catherine Wheeler, a member of the winning Keswick Hunt Club who competed aboard Something Special. Topping the Hunt Team competition was Mr. Stewart's Cheshire Foxhounds Team 2.

In addition to the Hunt Team Championship and associated classes, this year's Hunt Night also featured the Ladies Side Saddle Championship. Earning the championship were Becca Pelet and Galon Hapus.













Dr. Csaba Magassy Inducted into PNHS Hall of Fame

The Pennsylvania National Horse Show posthumously inducted former PNHS Foundation board member Dr. Csaba Magassy into the PNHS Hall of Fame, sponsored by the Wheeler Family, on Monday evening, October 16.

Magassy immigrated to the Canary Islands from Hungary during the second World War, before later relocating to Nebraska to study medicine at Creighton University. After completing his general surgery residency at the Washington Hospital Center, Magassy enlisted in the United States Air Force where he served for five years as the flight surgeon for the Thunderbirds. Magassy then returned to the U.S. and completed a plastic surgery residency at the University of California, San Francisco, and opened his own practice in 1972. He was highly regarded as an accomplished and devoted plastic surgeon, pilot and horseman.



In addition to being known as one of the Washington, D.C. area's best plastic surgeons, Magassy was an active member of the horse show community. His roots in the horse show community began when he met his former wife, Frances "Junior" Magassy. Junior Magassy – whose family owned and operated their own farm – was an avid competitor on the circuit and encouraged Csaba Magassy to join the Potomac Hounds Hunt, of which he was an active member for many years.



His philanthropic nature led him to join the foundation boards of both the Washington International Horse Show and the Pennsylvania National Horse Show. Says Junior Magassy, "He loved anything to do with horses; it was just a passion."

Csaba Magassy's participation in the Potomac Hounds led him to also frequently participate as an exhibitor at the PNHS on Hunt Night. In 2016, at 78 years old, Csaba Magassy won the Gentleman's Hunter Under Saddle Class aboard his own homebred, Thunderbird. In 2017, he received the reserve honor aboard his own Thunderbride.







Established in 1999, the PNHS Foundation is a 501(c) (3) organization that provides support for therapeutic riding programs, equine rescue efforts and the education and training of persons in equestrian endeavors.

In 2022, the Foundation awarded more than \$50,000 in grants to non-profit recipients both locally and across the nation. Foundation grants provide scholarships for therapy students, care for therapy and rescue horses, allow for the purchase of equipment for horses and riders and more.

2023 marks the eighth-annual LifeVac Therapeutic Riding Championships, scheduled to take place on Foundation Friday, October 20.
